Jim Ansley, 66, passed away on November 22, 2006 at his home in Bonnors Ferry. Funeral services were held Wednesday, November 15, 2006 at 10 a.m. in the Exhibit Hall at the Boundary County Fairgrounds, Bonnors Ferry, Idaho.

Jim Ansley was born James Henry Ansley in Amarillo, Texas on November 7, 1940 to Henry and Mary Ansley. Jim lived his early years in Northern Texas and western Oklahoma. He graduated from high school in 1959 at Lockney, Texas. In 1964 he graduated from Panhandle State College in Goodwell, Oklahoma receiving a Bachelors of Science Degree and an Army Officer Commission.
