**Alan Ambrose Bredy, 66**

Allan Ambrose Bredy, 66, passed away on Oct. 10, 2003 at his Naples, Idaho area home, after an extended illness. Funeral services were held on Tuesday, Oct. 14, 2003 at 2 p.m. with interment following in the Grandview Cemetery, Bonnors Ferry, Idaho.

Allan was born on June 30, 1937 in Eatonia, Saskatchewan, Canada to Edwin and Anna (Dietrich) Bredy. After his education, he served in the Army, Navy and Air Force, which he completed 13 years in the Air National Guard (Air Force Reserve). Allan retired from the service as a Master sergeant in the U. S. Air Force and served during the Vietnam Conflict from 1963-1967.
