Christopher Mykle Clark tragically passed on Oct. 5, 2004 in Vancouver, Wash. Christopher was thirty two

Christopher Mykle Clark was born to Chris and Larrie Clark on March 16, 1972 in Moscow, Idaho. The family moved back to their home town

of Bonners Ferry in 1976, where Christopher attended local schools; Morningsong Kindergarten, Mt. Hall, Praise Church Christian School through the eleventh grade, and finally graduated from Bonners Ferry High School in the spring of 1991.

Enlisting in the Marine Corps during his senior year, Christopher reported to basic training in September of 1991. It was the beginning of a 13-year military service that included the Marines, Idaho National Guard, and ultimately the Army Reserves. His Army reserve
