## Services today for Roy Copeland

Roy Copeland died on August 20 in the Community Hospital in Bonners Ferry. Funeral services will be held at 11 a.m. on Thursday, August 25, at the Bonners Ferry Funeral Chapel with Rev. Dellos Louden officiating. Interment will follow at the Grandview Cemetery.

Roy was born on September 1, 1905 in Douglas

County, Wash., to Frank and Sara Copeland. He moved with his family to Spokane as a child where he attended schools.

He worked in the area until he married Clista Casey in Spokane on August 29, 1925 after which he farmed for two years. In 1927 they moved to the Bonners Ferry area where he farmed until his

retirement in 1965. Roy has resided in Bonners Ferry until his death.

He is survived by his wife, Clista Copeland, of Bonners Ferry; 2 sons, Tom Copeland, of Bonners Ferry and Del Copeland, of Washington; two daughters, Mary Van Etten, of Bonners Ferry and Linda Powell, of St. Maries; two brothers, Harv

and Earl Copeland of Spokane; two sisters, Effie Pennick, of British Columbia and Elnora Hendry, of Missouri; 14 grandchildren and 19 great-grandchildren.
