## Henry Cunningham, Former Resident Here, Dies At Sandpoint

Henry Clinton Cunningham, 78, former Bonners Ferry resident, died last Friday, July 27, at his home in Sandpoint, of a heart attack, it was reported here this week.

Mr. Cunningham is survived by his widow, Rosa Moore Cunningham, and three daughters: Mrs. Margerie Chamberlain, Bonners Ferry; Mrs. Leatha Morgan, Cedar Point, Kan.; Mrs. Melva Sitton, Newport, Wash.; and two sons, Glenn of Cedar Point, Kan.; and John of Oakland, Calif.
