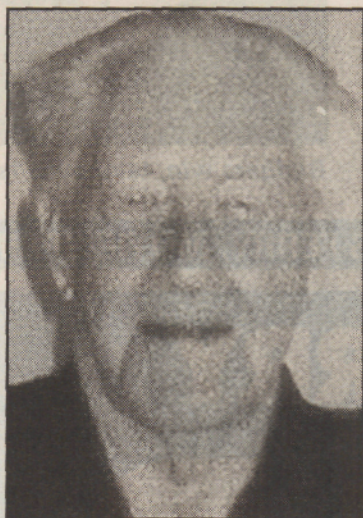

Myrl Alexander (Mike) Douglas, 88, passed away at the Community Hospital Extended Care on Oct. 8, 2003 after an extended illness.

Funeral Services were held on Oct. 11, 2003 at 10 a.m. in the Bonners Ferry Funeral Home in Bonners Ferry with internment following in the Grandview Cemetery in Bonners Ferry.

Mike was born on July 11, 1915 in Barnes, Kansas to Frank and Virginia (Harker) Douglas. In 1922 he moved with his family to Bonners Ferry, Idaho where he attend-
