# Oscar Halverson dead at age 90

Oscar B. Halverson died on July 4 in the Community Hospital E.C.F. in Bonners Ferry. No funeral services will be held.

Oscar was born on August 13, 1894 in Argyle, Washington to Gilbert and Olive Halverson. He entered the U. S. Army in 1918 and later was a farmer in Nebraska.

On December 27, 1927 he married Eleanora Johnson in Yankton, South

Dakota and in 1929 they moved to Montana where he worked in the mill. In 1934 they moved to Spirit Lake where he continued working in the mills and then in 1979 they moved to Bonners Ferry where he resided until his death. Oscar was a member of the Trinity Lutheran Church.
