Larry J. Hart, 37 year old resident of Boundary County since April of 1976, passed away at Community Hospital Monday morning as a result of injuries sustained in a construction accident near Saddle Pass on Smith Creek on December 13.

He grew up and received his education in Utah and following his education in construction work as a heavy equipment operator.
