Peter F. Heitt, 74 Succumbs Monday

Graveside services were held Tuesday at two o'clock for P. F. Heitt, who passed away here Monday after an illness of five years. The final services were conducted by Rev. M. R. Gallaher, with members of the local I. O. O. F. lodge, of which Mr. Heitt was a member, acting as pall bearers.

Peter F. Heitt was born in Preston, Clinton county, Iowa, November 9, 1866. On March 25, 1896, he married Miss Effie Belle Harrison at Ida Grove, Iowa. Eleven years later the family moved west, settling in Bonners Ferry.

Mr. Heitt followed his trade as a brick mason and cement worker, and many local buildings bear evidence of his skill. His last work was on the Fountain Cafe building at the time it was constructed.

Besides his widow Mr. Heitt is survived by a son, Ralph O. Heitt; a daughter, Mrs. Orval McVey, and a brother, Will Heitt, of Longmont, Colo.

Mr. Heitt, during his years of residence in this district, made many friends, who join with the community in extending heartfelt sympathy to the bereaved relatives.
