Timothy Clayton Jones, 63, a long time resident of Norfolk, Virginia, died on March 7, 2003 from a long-term illness.

Graveside Services will be held on Saturday, May 10, 2003 at 11 a.m. in the Grandview Cemetery, Bonnets Ferry, Idaho.

Tim was born on Feb. 10, 1940 to Inga and Les Jones in Coeur d'Alene, Idaho.

His family moved to Bonnets Ferry, Idaho in 1950, and he attended Bonnets Ferry High School, graduating in the class of 1958.

Tim attended college in Boise, Idaho before he joined the U.S. Navy in 1959. He served 26 years in the Navy, obtaining the rank of Chief Hospital Corpsman.

During this time, Tim served on several different types of ships and shore stations throughout the world, including tours in Vietnam with the Fleet Marine Force.

Additionally, he received his BS in Preventive Medicine from Merritt College and was actively pursuing his MS/PHD degree in the Industrial Hygiene/Occupational Health Specialist with the State of Virginia Health Department before accepting a position with the Preventive Medicine Department at the Adm. Joel T. Boone Branch

Medical Clinic, Naval Amphibious Base, Little Creek, Norfolk, Virginia in 1990 where he served as department head until 1999, when due to increased aggravation of illness and injuries sustained while he was on active duty, he was medically retired.

Throughout his life he loved the out-of-doors spending many hours hunting and fishing.

Mr. Jones is survived by two sons, Darrin Poole of San Diego, Calif. and Kenneth Poole of Virginia Beach; sister Patricia Pearson of Post Falls, Idaho; brother Dennis Jones of Bonnets Ferry, Idaho; several nieces and nephews; and his best friend, Leon Dozier.
