

Services Held for Porthill Resident Charley King, 60,

Charles Francis (Charley) King, 60-year-old Porthill resident, passed away at his home Dec. 25th following a lingering illness.

He was born January 4, 1908 at Hugo, Ore., and as a child moved with his parents to Utah and then to Idaho Falls, Idaho, where he received his education. He then returned to Utah, working at Hill air force base during World War II and in 1963 moved to Portland where he married Lillian Coulombe on February 4, 1963.
