Mike (Milan) Krpmotich, 94

Mike (Milan) Krmpotich, 94, died on Saturday, June 26, 2004 at the Extended Care Facility in the Boundary Community Hospital in Bonners Ferry, Idaho.

Born Feb. 15, 1910 in Coleraine, Minn., he was the son of Louis (Luka) and Sophie Krmpotich.

He was a graduate of Greenway High School and served in the U.S. Army in France and the Phillipines during World War II.

He lived in the Bovey/Coleraine area his entire life until moving to live with his son, Dan, in Bonners Ferry, Idaho in 1998.

Mike retired from U.S. Steel in 1972, but he and his brother, Dan, continued their logging business until 1984. His wife, Pearl, preceded him in death as did his brothers, Dan, Nick and sister Ann.

Survivors include his son, Dan, and grandchildren, Luka, Anya and Micah Krmpotich of Bonners Ferry, Idaho, and his daughter, Mary (Norm) Niskanen of Lake Havasu, Ariz.

There will be a graveside service at Lakeview Cemetery in late July.
