Rites Monday for Keith Leslie

Keith Leslie died October 2 at his home north of Bonnors Ferry. Graveside services were held Monday at 11:30 a.m. at Grandview Cemetery with Rev. Lowell Carlson officiating.

He was born Dec.18 in Bonnors Ferry, the son of William and Eva Leslie. He attended schools in Bonnors Ferry and after graduation he attended the University of Idaho, Moscow.

In 1929 Mr. Leslie married Gladys Beck in Bonnors Ferry. They resided in Bonnors Ferry until she preceded him in death in 1930 after the birth of their son, Bob Leslie.

On Feb 14, 1939, Keith married Edna Thompson in Libby. He lived his entire life in the Boundary County area where he worked in logging, farming, and trucking. He retired in 1972 due to ill health and enjoyed the out-of-doors, spending time hunting and fishing.
