Allen E. Lockman, 81

Allen E. Lockman, 81, formerly of Bonnere Ferry, died May 20, 2002 at his home in Deary, Idaho.

He was born Jan. 14, 1921 in Gordon, Wis. to Lester and Myrtle Houser Lockman.

He grew up and went to school in Wisconsin and came to Bonnere Ferry, Id. in 1939. It was there he met and married Rosetta Richardson on June 16, 1939.

He worked in the woods and sawmills prior to joining the Navy, serving from 1943 to 1944. Following his discharge, the family moved to Whitefish, Mont. where he worked in sawmills. They moved to Clarkston in 1970 and to Deary in 1979, where they lived since.
