## Marjorie Loraine Linnemeyer, 87

Marjorie Loraine Linnemeyer went to be with the Lord on March 25, 2005. Funeral Services will be held



on Saturday, April 2, 2005 at 2 p.m. in the Trinity Lutheran Church with internment in the Copeland Cemetery.

Marjorie was born on Dec. 11, 1917 to Chester and Doris (Marshall) Logan in Rexford, Kansas. She attended school through the 10th grade in Hugo, Colorado. Marjorie started to play the piano by picking out pieces by ear. She later took 2 years of music instruction and a course through the American College of Music.

Because of the Dust bowl in Colorado Marjorie moved with her parents to Copeland area on Thanksgiving Day, 1935. After moving here she met John Linnemeyer at a dance and later married on April 4, 1937 in Sandpoint.

After the retirement of Chester and Doris Logan in 1957 Marjorie and John took over the Mission Creek store. What was supposed to be for only three months lasted 21 years, one month and 18 days. They sold the store in 1978 and moved to Bonners Ferry where John passed away in 1979. Marjorie moved into the Senior Apartments in 1982.

Marjorie had a strong belief in God and did her devotions and read the Bible. She loved writing in her diary each day and to play cards. No one was a stranger to Marjorie for very long. She also had a great sense of humor. She was best known for playing the piano at

the Lutheran Church, Restorium, ECF Wing and at the Senior Citizens Center. She also played at dances while she was in different bands.

She was preceded in death by her parents Chester and Doris Logan, her husband John Linnemeyer, a brother Chester Blaine Logan and Sister Blanche Cureless.
