Denver LeMoin Marquis, 60

Denver LeMoin "Denny" Marquis, 60, lost his battle with cancer and passed peacefully into the hands of God on Oct. 13, 2003.

He was born Oct. 9, 1943 in Bedford, Indiana to Lee Marquis and the late Alice A. Johnson.

Denny moved as a young boy of two years to Santa, Ill. where he lived with his mother and stepfather, Roy E. Johnson.

He lived in St. Maries, Moyie Springs and on the Yaak in Montana as a young boy to a young man.

In the late 1950s to early 1960s, he moved to Bonners ferry with his family. He started his woods career at the early age of 16 in St. Maries.

He logged in Idaho and Montana until the young age of 40 when he was hit by a tree while working for Everhart Logging, which ended his logging career.

Denny was an avid white tail deer hunter, and he also hunted elk and bear. He also loved to fish in the lakes and streams of Idaho and Montana.

On Jan. 22, 1966 Denny married the love of his life, Sandie Irons. Two sons were born to Denny and Sandie, Roy Edward and Richard "Rick" Eugene.

Denny loved his sons very much and taught them everything he knew about the out of doors, hunting and fishing.

Denny leaves his wife, Sandie of 37 1/2 years at their home in Bonners Ferry; son Roy and his wife Ronda, granddaughter Jesseann of Bonners Ferry, grandson Cory of Moses Lake, Wash.; son Rick and his wife Tara, granddaughter Baylee of Coeur d'Alene; and numerous nieces and nephews in various parts of the United States. He will truly be missed by all.

He was preceded in death by his stepfather, Roy E. Johnson; half-brother, Mike Johnson and mother, Alice A. Johnson.
