Henry McGinnis, 81, Dies Wednesday After Suffering Stroke

Henry McGinnis, 81, a resident of Bonnors Ferry for 15 years, died in Community hospital Wednesday afternoon following a stroke suffered four days ago.

Services have been tentatively set for next Monday, pending arrival of relatives. Rites will be held here and interment will be in Greenwood cemetery in Spokane.

Mr. McGinnis was born September 1, 1874, in Bedford, Ind. He is survived by his widow, Mrs. Rosa Belle McGinnis, four sons, William A. McGinnis of Whitefish, Mont.; Jesse of San Carlos, Calif.; Melvin and Henry, both of Spokane. He also leaves four brothers, George of Terre Haute, Ind.; Reed of Clinton, Ill.; Bart of Elm Grove, Wis.; and Fred of Bedford, Ind.

He was a retired Milwaukee railroad employee and was a member of the Brotherhood of Railway Car Men. He was also a member of the Modern Woodmen of America lodge.
