Grace McGlocklin

Grace McGlocklin died Dec. 2 in the Community Hospital Extended Care Facility in Bonners Ferry.

Graveside services were held Saturday, December 5 at 11 a.m. at the Grandview Cemetery with Rev. Larry Nelson officiating.

Grace McGlocklin was born Sept. 7, 1887 in McCune, Kan. to Dennis and Mary Ratcliff. She attended schools in McCune, Kan., after which she moved with

her parents to Bonners Ferry in 1906.

She lived with her parents on the North Bench until she married James H. McGlocklin March 24, 1910.

They lived in Bonners Ferry until 1916 when they moved to Coeur d'Alene, where James worked for the Rutledge Mill. In 1921, they returned to Bonners Ferry, and then in 1926, they moved back to the North Bench where she resided until 1956
