**H. L. Medbury Dies Suddenly.**

H. L. Medbury, one of the early pioneers of Bonners Ferry, passed away yesterday afternoon at the home of Mr. and Mrs. E. S. Cave. Death was due to heart trouble. Mr. Medbury had been ill for several weeks, but the first of the week recovered sufficiently to walk from his home to the business section of town.

Arrangements for the funeral are being made today. Mr. Medbury has no relatives in this district. His wife died here some six years ago.

Mr. Medbury came to Bonners Ferry before the construction of the Great Northern Railway in this section. He was a brick mason by trade. He was well known in this county, was well liked by everyone and will be greatly missed by hosts of friends.
