

## Harold C. Method

Harold C. Method, 73, died Monday, at Bonner General Hospital. Born February 8, 1904 at Decatur, Nebraska, he married Ruth H. Fetty on June 7, 1927 at Invale, Nebraska. They would have celebrated their 50th wedding anniversary in June.
