Fae Monger, 91, passed away Wednesday, May 19, 2004 at the Boundary County Nursing Home



in Bonners Ferry, Idaho. Funeral Services were held May 25, 2004 at the Bonners Ferry Funeral Home in Bonners Ferry, Idaho with internment following in the Grandview Cemetery.

Fae was born on Jan. 9, 1913 in Post Falls, Idaho to PT and Alma (Bates) Casey. She attended schools in Cheney, Wash. and in 1927 moved to Bonners Ferry, Idaho where she continued her education graduating in 1929 from Bonners Ferry High School.

She worked for J.C.Penny's for about 10 years. During this time, she met and on July 7,

1941 she married Martin Monger. They later moved to a farm which they owned and operated until 1965. She worked for many years for Taft's Department Store in Bonners Ferry from the mid-1950's and continued for over 30 years until she retired in the 1980's. Fae and Martin moved into Bonners Ferry in 1965 where Fae has resided home until late 1997 when she moved to the Community Restorium. Throughout her life she loved to fish, enjoyed crocheting, gardening, pinochle parties, and spending time talking to family and friends on the phone.
