James Kingsley Oziah

James Kingsley Oziah died Jan. 27 in the E.C.F. Wing of the Community Hospital in Bonners Ferry. Funeral services were held Sunday, Jan. 31, at 2 p.m. in the Bonners Ferry Funeral Home Chapel with Pastor Don Reiber officiating. Burial was held in the Grandview Cemetery.

Oziah was born Dec. 8, 1890 in Lexington, Okla., to Minot and Nancy Oziah. He moved to Idaho Springs, Colo., in 1896 with his parents. He attended schools

there and in Wisconsin, and finished his education in the Cheyenne River Academy in North Dakota.

After he finished school, he worked in construction. In 1920, he moved to the Moyie Springs area where he farmed.

On December 29, 1941, he married Ruth Arvilla Roberts in Pendleton, Ore. He has resided on the farm until his death.

He was active in farming and working around the farm until illness prevented him

from doing so in April, 1981. He enjoyed painting and was a member of the Seventh Day Adventist Church.
