Funeral Services Held Today for Hans F. Peterson

Funeral services for Hans F. Peterson, Naples resident, will be conducted today (Thursday) at 2:00 p. m. from the Whitney funeral chapel. Mr. Peterson died March 19 at a sanitarium at Gooding. He was 70 years old.

Rev. Gerald Amundson of the Trinity Lutheran church will read the service. Bill Brazier will sing funeral hymns, with Ferne Crowley accompanying. Interment will be the family plot at Porthill.

Mr. Peterson was born in Kolding, Denmark, on January 9, 1885. He had lived in the Naples community for 36 years, where he was an early day logging contractor, associated with H. E. Brown and Peter Moe.

After dissolving partnership with his associates, Mr. Peterson took up farming which had been his work prior to his death.

He is survived by his widow, Eric Peterson, three brothers in Saskatchewan and a sister in Denmark.
