Services Today For Mary J. Rorke

Services will be held from the Morse Funeral Home at two o'clock this afternoon for Mary Jane Rorke, 2½ year old daughter of Mr. and Mrs. Harold M. Rorke, who was drowned near the family home in the Fitzpatrick district last Friday morning. Elder D. T. Burke of the Adventist church in Sandpoint will officiate. Interment will be in Grandview cemetery.

The drowning occurred at about eleven o'clock Friday morning. The girl's mother, missing the youngster, began searching for her and discovered the body near a milk shed on the drainage ditch. It is thought that the little girl fell off a narrow bridge across the ditch.

Music for the services will be furnished by the girls' sextette under Mrs. Martin. Four of the girls will act as pallbearers.

There are two surviving sisters, Loretta Mae, 4, and Patricia Ann, 1½ months, and one brother, Gordon Jay, 5.
