### Last Rites Today

Florence Roberta Spurgeon, 79 year old Bonners Ferry resident, passed away at her home early Monday morning, Jan. 28. She had been in failing health the past six months.

She was born October 17, 1882 at Spurgeon Bay, Wis., the daughter of Alex and Udora Hall Noble. When she was four years old, the family moved to Topeka, Kans. and later to Divide, Colo. She received her education there and lived in that area for many years.

She came to Bonners Ferry in July 1940, and on April 11, 1945 she was married to George O. Spurgeon at Libby, Mont. She was a member of the Methodist church and of the Springs Temple, Pythian Sisters.

Survivors are her husband, George O. (Pearl) Purinton and Mrs. Edward (Pearl) Hoagland, both of Don (Myrtle) Hoagland, Flor-Bonners Ferry; Mrs. Walter (Flor-Keneth (Grace) Brudesech of St. Maries and Mrs. Don (Stella May) Laird of Philadelphia; three step-sons and three stepdaughters, also 20 grandchildren and several step-grandchildren.
