Daniel L. Venard, 93, of Macomb, Illinois, died Wednesday, April 2, 2003 at 5 a.m. at his residence.

He was born Dec. 22, 1909 in Vermont, Illinois, the son of Edward E. and Clara L. VanAntwerp Venard.

He first married Frances Taylor and then married Laura Kaakinen and then later married Elizabeth Perkins Estes.

He is survived by one daughter, Mary C. Stevenson of Charlotte, N.C.; three sons: William J. Venard, Robert T. Venard and Paul J. Venard, all of Bonners Ferry, Idaho. He was preceded in death by two sons, Dan L. Venard II and Erik J. Venard, and two brothers.

He attended schools in Vermont, Illinois and Macomb, Illinois, and he attended Western Illinois Teachers College from 1927 to 1929.

He has an A.B. degree from Northern Michigan University and a Master's degree from the University of Idaho.

He taught in schools in Michigan, Illinois and Idaho. He was employed by Douglas Aircraft during WW2 as a statistician and production scheduler.

He worked for the X-ray Department of the General Electric Company in Chicago and Milwaukee as supervisor of quality control and production methods methods engineering in the X-ray tube department for 14 years.
