Harriet Voss, 84

Harriet Robinson Voss, 84, passed away on May 10, at the Extended Care of the Community Hospital in Bonners Ferry. Private Services were held with interment in the Grandview Cemetery in Bonners Ferry.

Harriet was born on Jan. 9, 1918 in Fort Collins, Co. to Harry Barton and Violet Iris (Yockey) Robinson. After her education she married John T. Fields on Dec. 21, 1933 in Torrington, Wy.

They operated a Dairy on Highland Flats until John's death in 1966. Harriet then went to work at Cone's Café and Grocery where she met Jack Voss. They were married on July 14, 1967 in Coeur d'Alene.

They made their home in Bonners Ferry and she went to work at the Community Hospital as a nurse's aide. Jack preceded her in death in Jan. 21, 1968. She continued working at the hospital for many years before she was forced to retire due to disabling rheumatoid arthritis.

Harriet was a member of the Boundary County Archery Club for many years.
