C. Carrel Warn, 80, resident of Bonnors Ferry since 1958, passed away Sunday evening, December 30, following a short illness.

He was born January 30, 1893, at Richmond, Va., the son of George H. and Lucy Peck Warn. As a small boy he moved with his family to

Iowa where he received his education, graduating from Iowa State College at Ames with a degree in mechanical engineering. Following his education he moved to Helena, Mont., where he was associated with Cairds Engineering Works as a field engineer.

In 1935 he married Jessie M. Lytle. During WW II he moved to Seattle, Wash., and was associated with Boeing Aircraft as a mechanic.

Returning to Libby, Mont., he became associated with Niell Lumber Company and held this position until 1958 when he retired and moved to Bonnors Ferry where he has since resided.

He was a life member of the Morning Star Lodge No. 5 A.F. & A.M. Helena, and also a member of Billings Consistory.

Survivors include his wife, Mrs. Jessie M. Warn of Bonnors Ferry; three sons, David E. Warn and Lawrence Warn of Helena and Donald Warn of Georgia; two step daughters, Mrs. Ellen Kennedy and Mrs. Gwene Oliver of Seattle; and one step son, Leslie A. Lytle of Bonnors Ferry.

Graveside rites will be conducted at 11:00 a.m., Thursday, January 3, at Grandview Cemetery with Bonnors Ferry Lodge No. 43 A.F. & A.M. officiating.
